

Spoons Up! is a fingerless gloves knitting pattern

Knit in fingering weight yarn, this pattern generates a tube of double layered knitting to keep your wrists extra warm. There is no thumb gusset or shaping to this pattern, which makes it one size fits all, and easy to take on or off if you're a chronic hand-washer like me.

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Spoons Up! fingerless gloves Gauge: 6 stitches to the inch, blocked

You will need:

- 1 skein of main color fingering weight yarn (approx.. 100 yards)
- 1 skein of background color fingering weight yarn (approx.. 100 yards)
- size 1 needles
- size 2 needles

Using size 1s, cast on 60 stitches. Join in round using your favorite method. Knit 12 rows of garter stitch (six garter ridges). Switch to size 2s and knit 1 round plain stockinette. Knit chart below. Once complete, knit 1 round plain stockinette. Switch to size 1s. Knit 12 rows of garter stitch. Cast off using Jeny's surprisingly stretchy bind off.
